

LEARN NOT TO BURN!

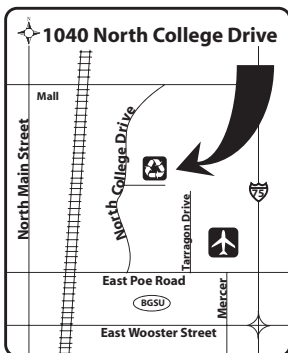
It's **bad** for the environment and can be **against the law**.

- Dead animals

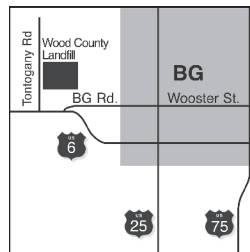
Open fires can release many kinds of toxic fumes. Violations can result in substantial penalties! There ARE alternatives - consider taking waste to the following locations:
